1. Project Status

2.1. Tasks Completed

The detailed plan for the implementation will be drawn up based on this, and will be presented on the last conference call before the holiday break on 14th December.

- Emmanuel is currently in the process of negotiating contracts with the two people who have been offered the developer positions, with the aim of starting work on the project from 1st January 2012.
- A call has been scheduled for Thursday 8th December at 3pm CAT / 8am EST between Matt Berg from the Earth Institute at Columbia U and the Jembi team and others (including Randy Wilson (MSH) and Zaharani Kalunga (PEPFAR/Tanzania)). The aim of the call is to share experiences of developing facility registries, and to discuss the possibility of aligning the work being done.
